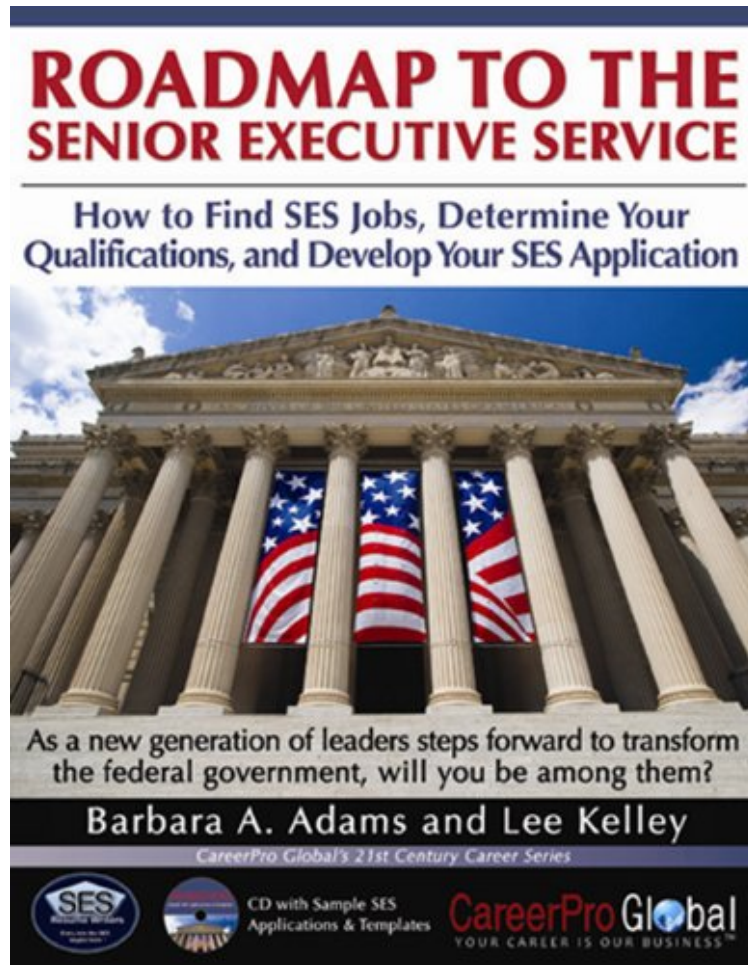

available for free (and more current) at opm.gov - the US Government's own website that contains the background rules and regulations for USAJobs.com - which is the USG's only portal into Federal hiring below the Presidential Appointment level. Where the book really falls short is the limited to zero discussion of all the various "backdoor" programs that lead to SES appointments. In DCMA alone, there are at least three pathways. While the book is of good information and the searchable CD (which replicates the book) is a nice feature; I do not believe, based on my own applications, that the examples are fully on point or comprehensive enough to submit an SES application with a high probability of success. The SES training pathways programs are so highly competitive, that extensive understanding and word-smithing of the application requires the latest OPM guidelines which this edition (nor can any traditional book) can achieve simply due to the mechanics of publishing.
