The best word will have a sense with the intended meaning and associated senses that least conflict with the conceptual environment of the thought being communicated. There is no table of contents, index, or ANYTHING inside to make this book usable - just a weird page inside the cover explaining that any disputes are under exclusive jurisdiction of a court system in India with a yahoo.com email address if you have a concern.
