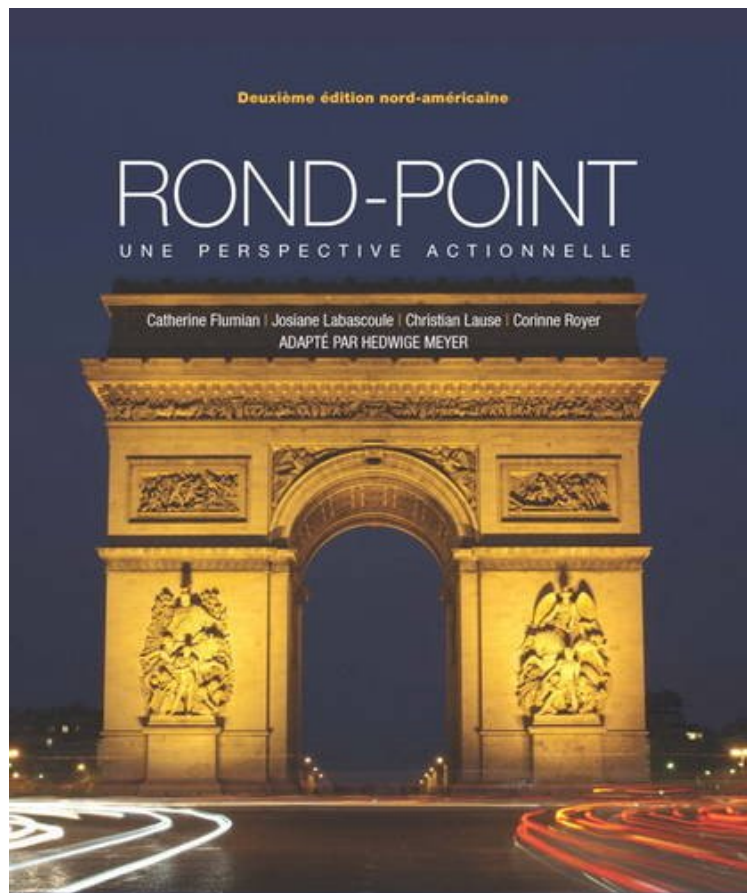

Not sure why you don't learn how to say days of the week or tell time until Chapter 5? By chris salazar The structure of this book just makes no sense. It starts off nicely, and you learn with numbers and so on, but there is a sudden turn after the first chapter. You don't learn how to tell time or say the days of the week until Chapter 5 (80% of

the way into the semester), which are things you actually need to know. You don't learn the months until Chapter 4, yet you learn about interviewing people in Chapter 2. There is not much help this book can do, and the activities do not make sense either. The real way to learn is to attend your class every day and let the teacher do their jobs. This simply isn't a book you can learn from or even supplement on days you might miss class. I found that our French instructor used many of her own readings as opposed to the book simply because it was so bad (not to mention CRAZY expensive). The only thing good about this book was the 1-2 pages of review (vocabulary, etc) at the end of each chapter that let helped me prepare for tests. One of my biggest complaints about this book is that, as a native English speaker (and decent Spanish), the pronunciation is VERY difficult if you don't start young. By chapter 2, the audio that accompanies the book is speaking full-fledge French that is nearly impossible to follow along with. The only way to get by is to listen very carefully and hope that out of a full sentence, you recognized one or two words and can try and piece it together based on context and cues.
