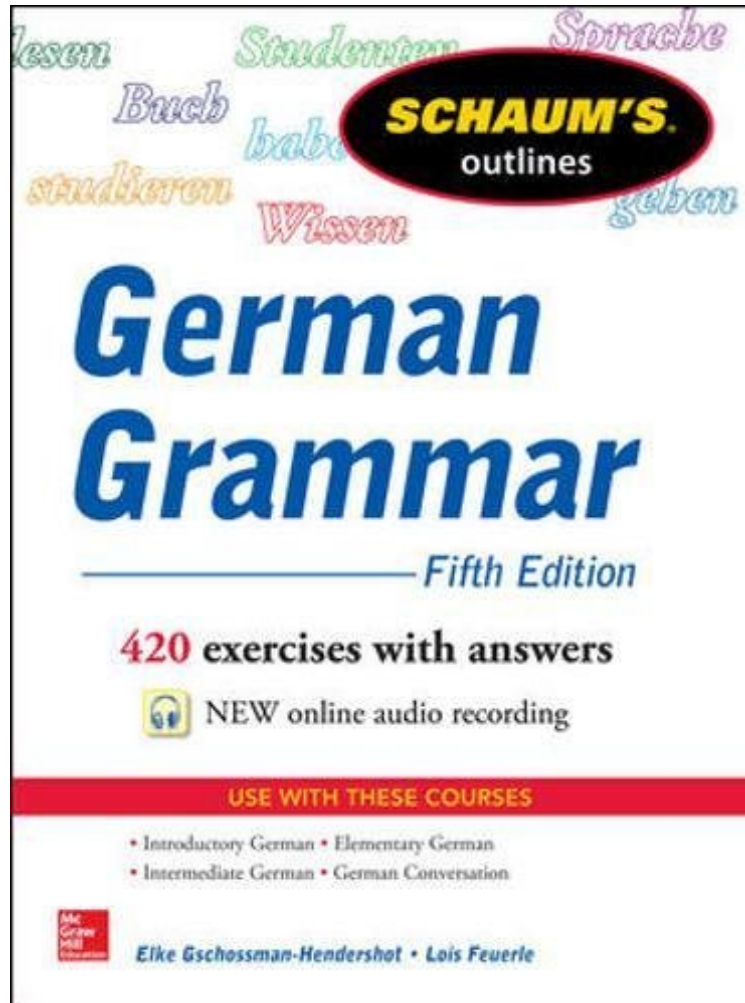

By Stephan D This is a good overview of German grammar, as far as anything can be. It's a complex thing to slog through and has been useful mainly by working on small sections at a time and trying to tie that into reading and work in other books. It would be hard and probably unproductive for any student to read this cover to cover. I did find some odd things like lists of examples of a particular case that include sentences that don't really illustrate that case, either because they just don't or because they have a case where a pronoun or noun does not change case so it doesn't serve as a good example. But on the whole the book does a good job shedding at least some light on the complexity of German grammar.
