This profession involves so much ethical and legal gray area and it's not always easy to know what the best decision is to make when dealing with ethically or legally ambiguous decisions involving your students. My only critique of this book is that some laws vary state to state so it's not universally applied; I would recommend supplementing this book with one that addresses state education laws of your own state (which Dr. Hatch mentions anyway).
