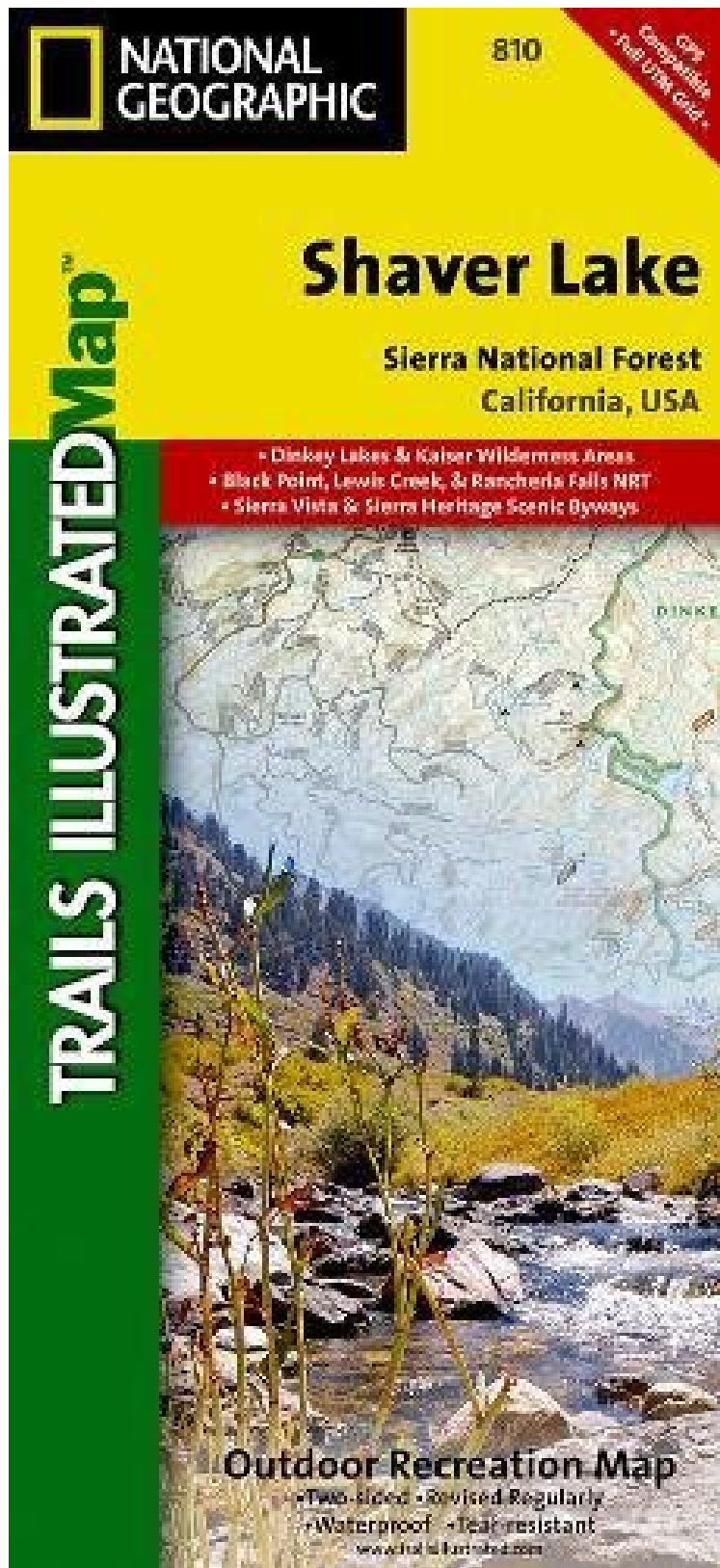

I took several day hikes in which I consulted the map on many occasions. As USGS quad maps are harder and harder to obtain, I find myself using these hybrid topo maps. I found this map to be detailed enough for almost any application. It was accurate and it was easy to read the legend items and contour lines. This map is also made of a flexible plastic material. This came in handy when my dog pulled me into a creek during a break in my hike. We slid down some slick rocks for a few meters before pulling ourselves out. After drying out for a few minutes, I noticed that the map (which had been in my pocket) was gone. I looked downstream and saw it at the bottom of a 4-5 foot deep pool. I used a long pine branch to fish it out and the map was none the worse for wear. Totally fine. A paper map would have been a ball of mush at that point. So in this case, this product was superior to a paper USGS topo map. I just wish these maps were available for more areas. Great product.
