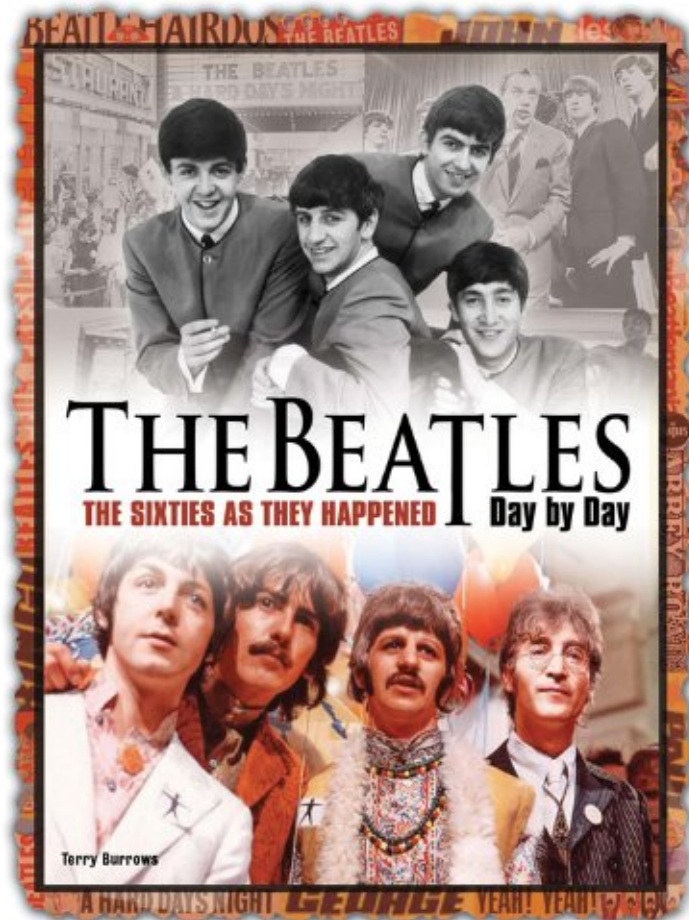

were yesterday, August 15, 1965. It was the day after my fifteenth birthday, when I visited my cousins that summer in Brooklyn, New York. They had tickets to see the Beatles in live concert, and from the moment I found out, I was in a state of shock. I rode the trains from South Brooklyn to Shea Stadium, home of the New York Mets, where we attended the incredible concert. There was over 55,000 fans there, people screaming and passing out, and police officers everywhere. I was mesmerized the entire day, and have never seen a crowd that big in my life. The Beatles Day by Day follows the group through their astonishing and turbulent period of unmatched success, ending at the break up of the band in 1970. Paul McCartney publicly announced he was leaving in April 1970, and after legal wrangling, the formal break up occurred in January 1975. This book includes details of all the recording sessions, all the tours, and all the major incidents in their personal lives. Panels and sidebars list all the tracks that they recorded, and contain first hand accounts from those who saw them or worked with them. The book not only illustrates their own personal development, but also shows how they fitted into the 1960's zeitgeist. The book is enhanced with 400 illustrations, not only of photographs and stills, but facsimiles of memorabilia. The Beatles Day by Day makes a wonderful addition to the library of any American historian, music lover, or Beatles fan.
