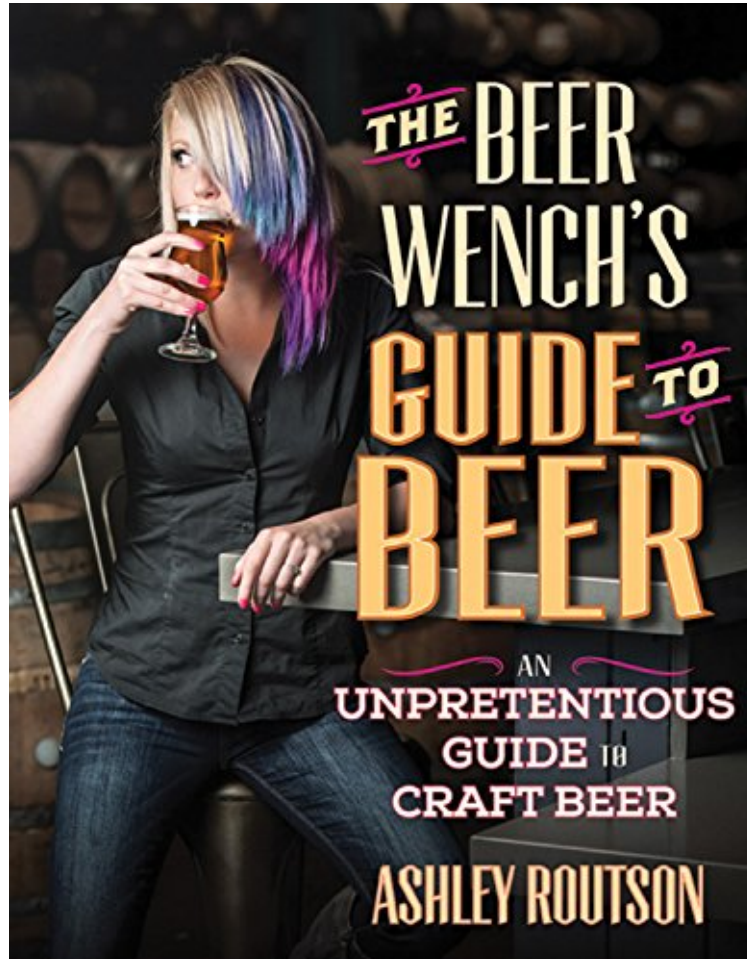

The Author assumes nothing about the reader's knowledge on the subject, she dives right in with basic concepts definitions given in very easily understood language, while not talking down to those not already 'in-the-know'. For those readers with more advanced knowledge, the definitions don't seem to be 'dumbed down' or over simplified. I found the consistent structure of the beer style explanations very well laid out and the descriptions to be very real, honest refreshing. After 3 decades in the Craft Brewing World, I

enjoyed the descriptions for their sense of fun and discovery. The pictures were amazing, the sections on beer mixology cooking make the book very interactive. It can be read from front to back (which it should) but can just as easily be read with pages chosen randomly. She makes you feel like you're sitting with her in her kitchen, she's so down to earth. That means you don't have to know the difference between a lager and an ale and what makes it golden, red, brown, or black, she'll tell you.
