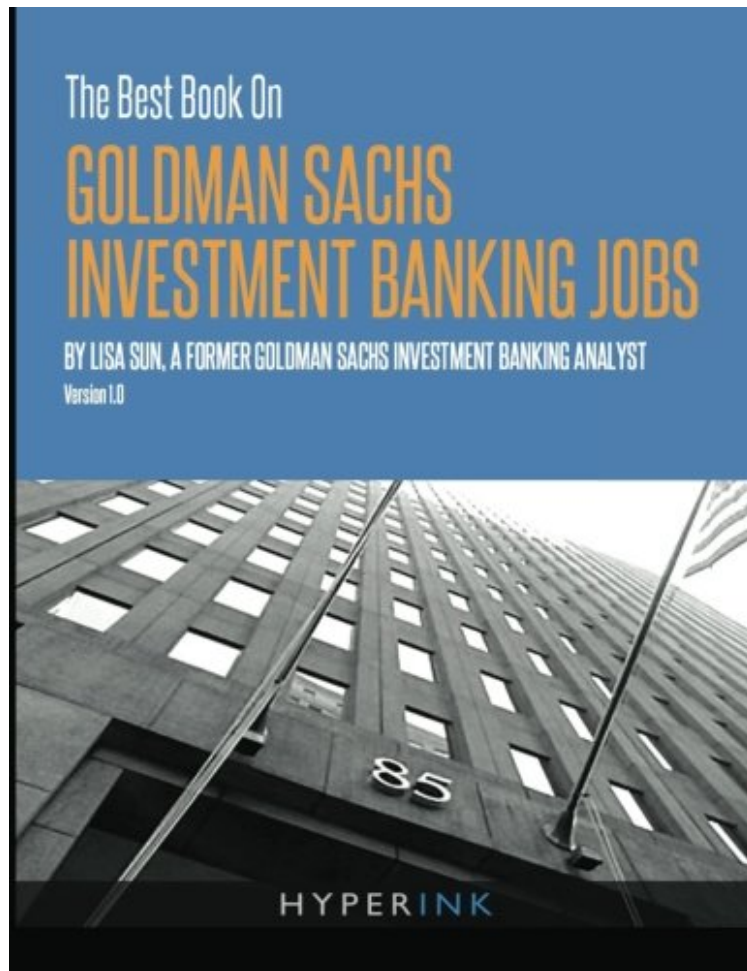

I bought the Kindle version for little more than half that. Example: What should you read as research to prepare for the interviews? Vault guides, the book "Goldman Sachs: Culture of Success", company website and do a google search for recent news. Did I need this book to tell me that? As for interview questions, the author cites several very standard industry-wide questions and then suggests you buy the Vault guide for more detail. I give two stars rather than one star because I think that this IS a fine OUTLINE of the things to think about. But that's about it. Notice that all the 5 and 4 star reviews (at this time) only review this one book or only review this plus other books by the same publisher. Odd. I am going to be very wary of future titles coming out
