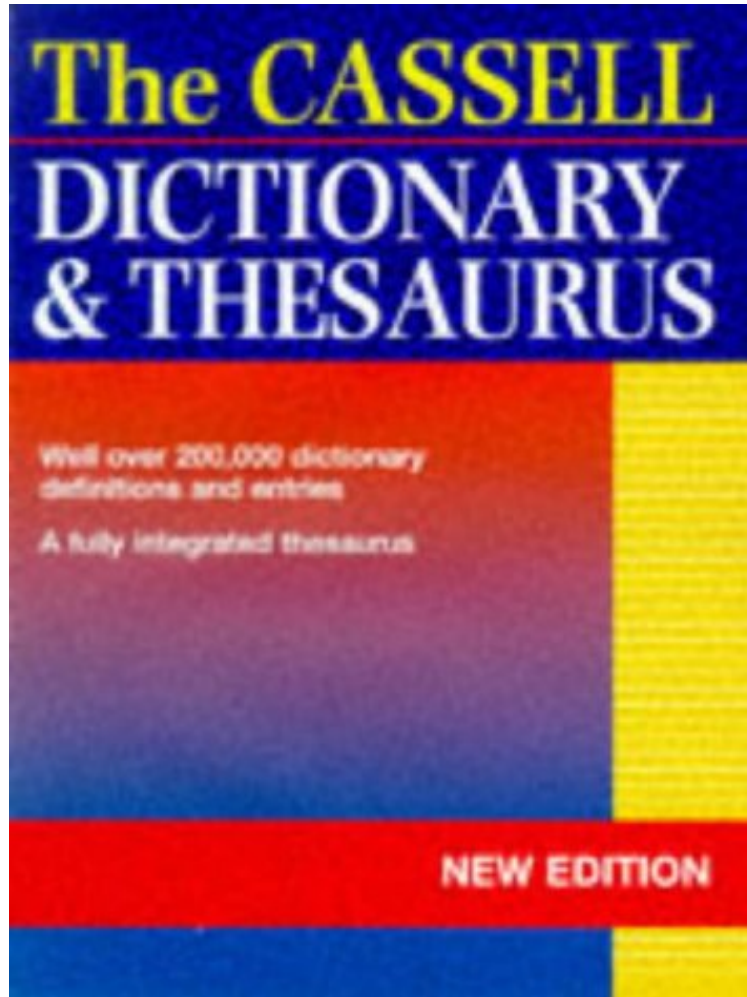

When using it, I repeatedly come away with the impression of great efficiency: that I can find any word I have ever read or heard in the English language in one minute or less. I often need the best word for a phrase and the sense that it is the best choice that exists in the English language. I consistently get this level of satisfaction. With this reference work, I consistently find the best word I have ever heard for any sense of an idea or concept. All I need do is first identify the ballpark or general meaning of it to look under. The thesaurus does the rest of the search by presenting increasingly specific instantiations of its more general terms; herein lies its great value. As expected, most of its

entries are words presented in the standard format of type of part-of-speech, declensions, ordered nuances identified by number according to their frequency of use, example phrases and sentences, and efficient/short denotations. BUT IT'S GREAT VALUE LIES IN THE CONVENIENCE OF A VERY GOOD THESAURUS placed at the end of this for most of the words. The Thesaurus is the most useful and practical for English production I have every found. I use it daily; much more than Roget's Thesaurus. In fact, synonyms and antonyms are laid out in a consistently ordered and prioritized fashion (better than Roget's) from most similar (or directly opposite) to most diffuse and tangential. Both types are included at lists' end. You soon learn where to look for synonyms and antonyms in the lists for the purpose of finding the level of generality of the word you want. It is a writer's treasure house and right hand. I have worn out two copies through daily use, and am now wearing out a third.

It's two books in one, with over 200,000 entries -- and that saves time and trouble! This combination of dictionary and thesaurus brings you right to the word you need. Because the synonyms are linked to definitions, it's less likely you'll choose one that doesn't convey exactly the right meaning. Of course, it also does everything you'd expect a regular dictionary to do -- detail grammar, highlight slang, suggest antonyms, and give pronunciation guidelines.
