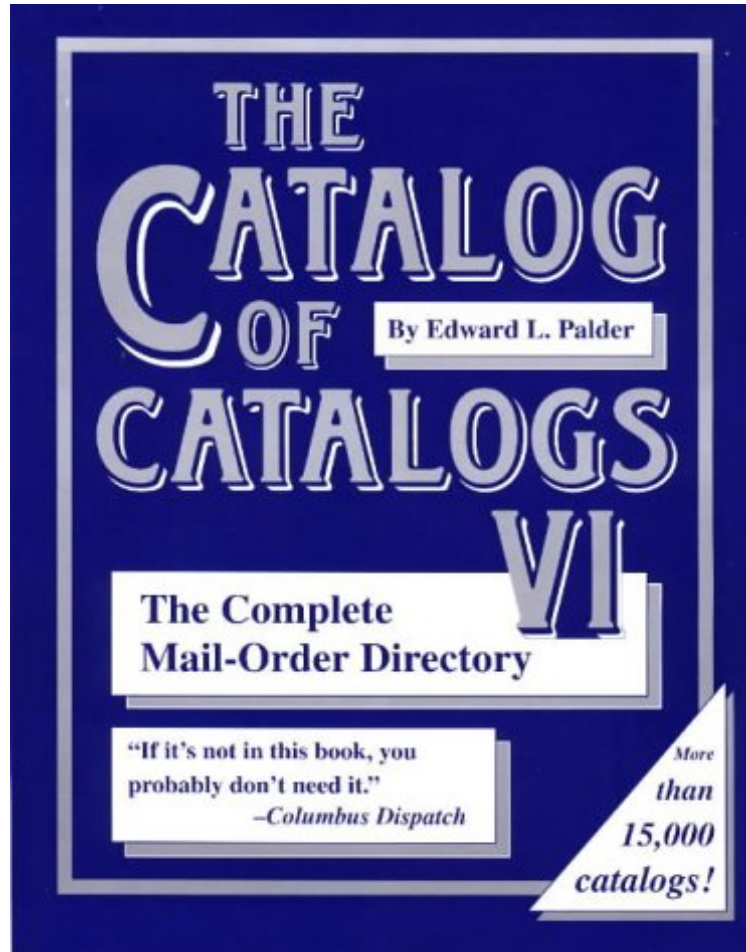

Still believing that some people may not have Internet access, Palder does not include online retailers with exclusively online catalogs. Thus, .com is not listed.
