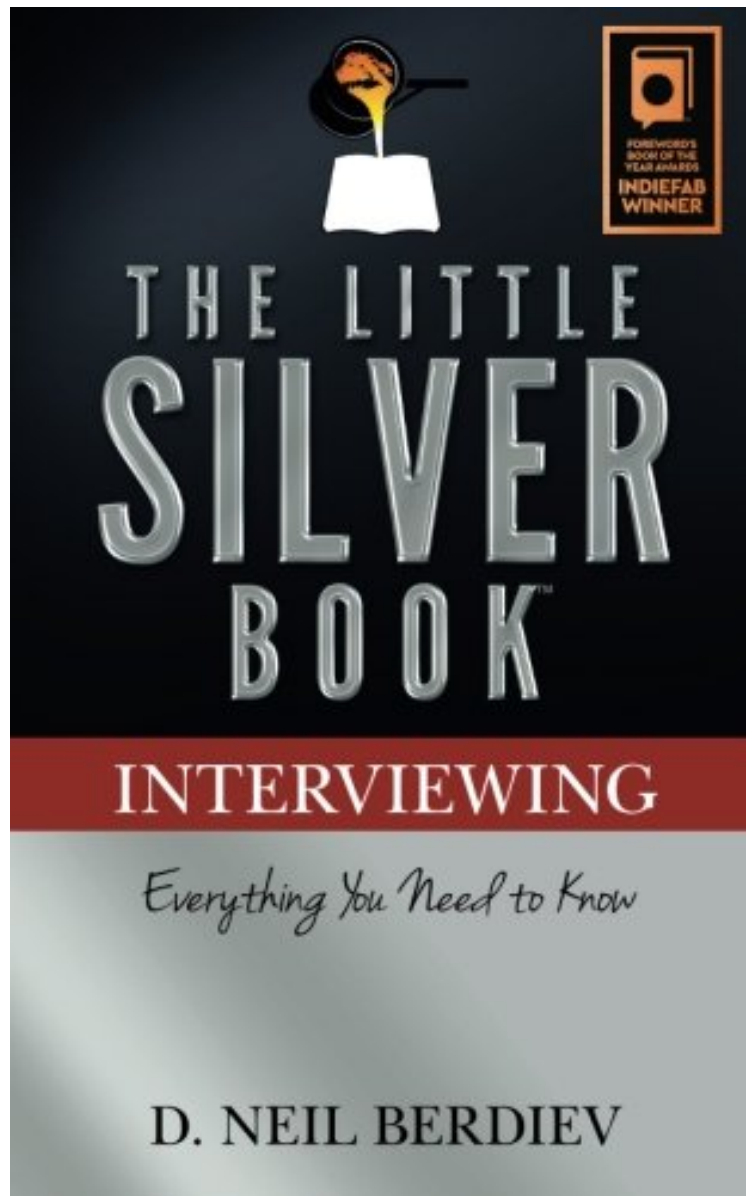

I have a lot of experience with interviewing as I have been working with financial services training programs and interviewed hundreds of college age kids over the years. I would say that all of interviewees would have benefited from reading this book and putting the tips into practice. Interviewing is a skill that is not taught in college (save for the few kids who drop by the career center usually too late in their college experience) yet most kids go to college in the hopes of finding a great job and career after graduation.
