It is also one of largest I own, having a size of 16.2/4 by 13.1/8 or 42cm by 33.5 cm. It weights about 8 lbs. The book contains 175 plates which are the left and right side pages. If you don't know the latin numbering system you are out of luck since each plate is numbered accordingly. Plate CLXXV is Plate 175. You not only find maps, but also uniforms flags, equipment, weapons. A table indicates the content of each plate. There is also a nomenclature of maps, and sketches to locate the particular town, area. A third list mentions the names of the persons responsible for drawing maps, sketches, etc. A book in good condition is hard to find since most have been marked or poorly handled.
