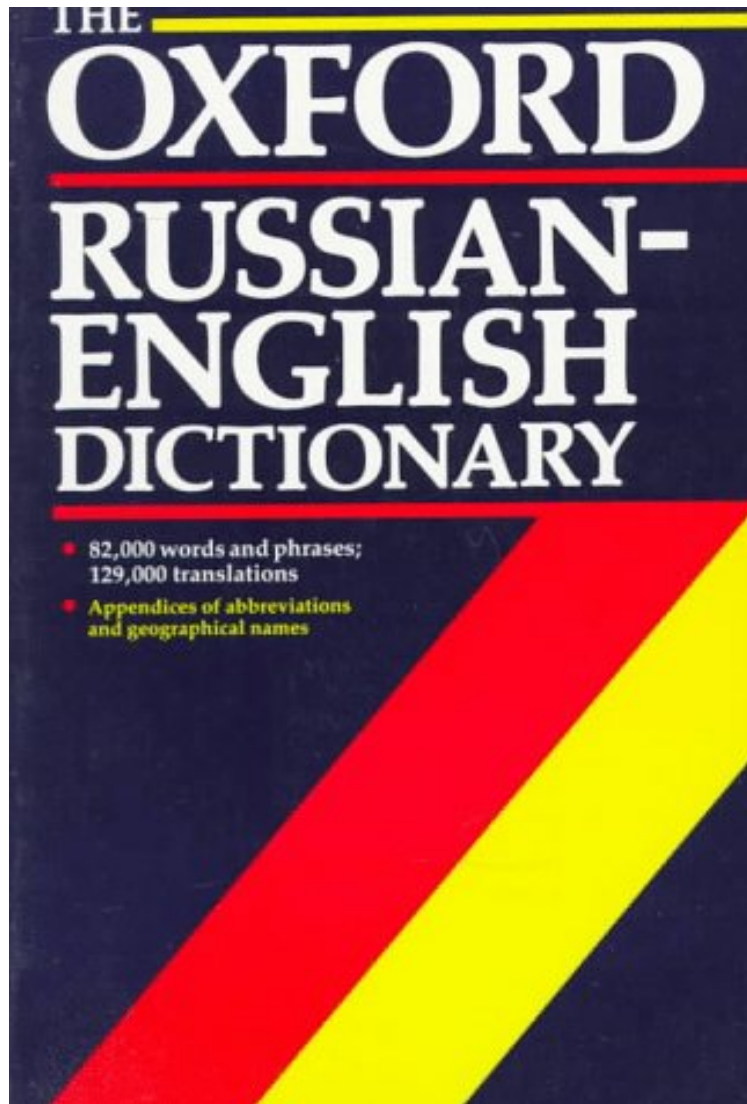

I have used this dictionary quite a bit already, and it hasn't let me down once. I probably won't need another dictionary until my Russian is good enough that I can use a Russian-only dictionary, which shouldn't be sooner than a few years from now. Though it is not a hardcover, it's not a paperback either - I think it's some kind of two-layer vinyl or plastic material, which seems durable enough. If you're beginning to read in Russian, or already do but need a good dictionary, I would definitely recommend this.
